Let's make a small room on the roof and put in it a bed and a table, a chair and a lamp for him. Then he can stay there whenever he comes to us." 2 Kings 4:8-10 NIV.*

Without being asked, she recognized the need to *sustain the work* of the man of God. She provided a place of rest and honor for the vessel carrying God's assignment. In return, she did not only receive a miraculous son, but sustained divine attention over her family through multiple seasons.

When her son died suddenly, Elisha prayed and the boy was raised back to life.

*He went in, shut the door on the two of them and prayed to the Lord. 2 Kings 4:33 NIV.*

Later, when famine struck the land, she received insider information ahead of time.

*Elisha had said to the woman whose son he had restored to life, "Go away with your family and stay for a while wherever you can, because the Lord has decreed a famine in the land that will last seven years." 2 Kings 8:1 NIV.*

Upon her return after the famine, divine favor preserved her possessions.

*The king assigned an official to her case and said to him, "Give back everything that belonged to her, including all the income from her land from the day she left the country until now." 2 Kings 8:6 NIV.*

This woman's consistent honoring of God's work ensured that heaven sustained oversight over her affairs—even during crises.

In business, when you prioritize Kingdom assignments—whether through your influence, your giving, your time, or your platform—you enroll your business under divine management. God's "oversight" does not expire during economic downturns, unexpected losses, or systemic failures.

Sustained oversight is activated by consistent, heartfelt commitment to God's interests, not occasional acts of convenience.

## **Business Story:**

### **Adanna's Bakery: Sustained by Purpose**

Adanna owned a growing bakery business. Early on, she dedicated a portion of her proceeds to funding outreach programs, feeding children in less privileged neighborhoods.

Even when tough times came—rising costs, a fire outbreak in her first shop—clients began seeking her out, sometimes bypassing bigger, flashier bakeries. Unexpected grants and property owners favored her with flexible leases.

She realized that while others were surviving on promotions, she was thriving under protection. *"It was not my hustle,"* she said, *"It was the covenant I honored."*

Her business became proof that when you take care of God's work, He takes care of yours, continually.

## **Chapter Twenty Two**

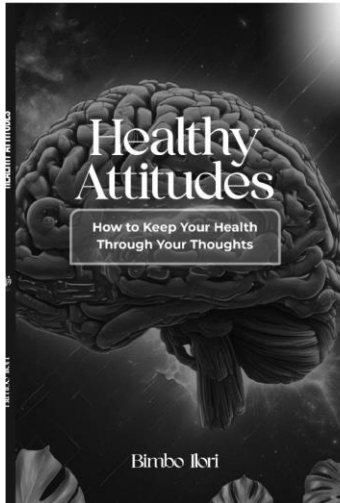
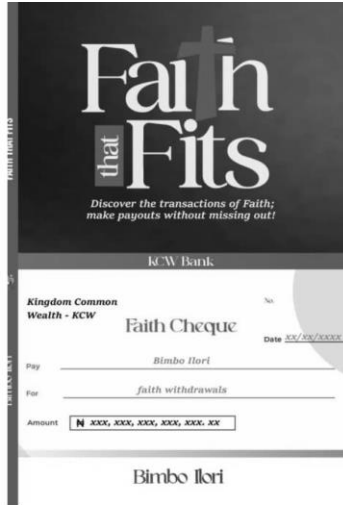
