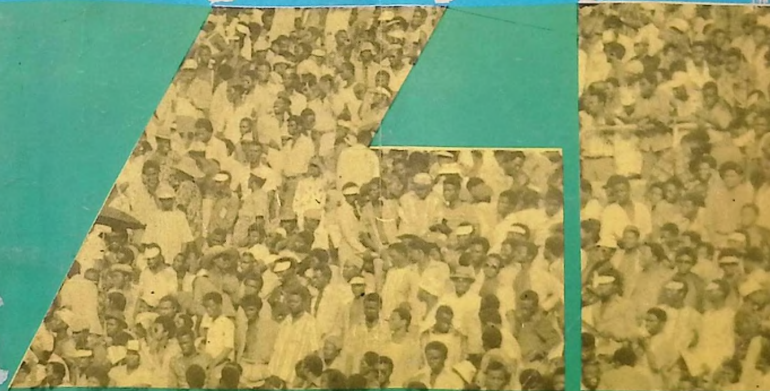

# TAX EVASION

## -Bid To Curb The Social Ill

TAX evasion, since the advent of self-rule has been an intractable problem in our society. It is the practice by which the tax payer arranges his affairs legally so that he pays less tax than he might otherwise have done or ends up not paying at all.

Some people do this by false declaration of income. For a long time, highly-placed people and some big companies escape tax payment. Efforts have been made in the past to curb this grave social ill, which is now having a far-reaching effect on the nation's economy.

As a means of making sure that citizens performed one of their civic duties by regularly paying their taxes, the Federal Government a few years back directed that before some bank transactions such as obtaining foreign exchange could be made, one must produce three years' tax clearance certificates as evidence of regular payment of tax.

At the turn of 1979 it was also made compulsory that anyone who wished to vie for an elective political position in the country must be able to produce tax clearance for a period not less than three years, failing which such a person was immediately disqualified. Tenders for government projects also required tax clearance certificates.

Despite these bold steps taken, the

Federal and State Inland Revenue Boards still have a lot of work to do in achieving the aim of reducing tax evasion in the society. This fact was pointed out to the 41st meeting of the Joint Tax Board.

From available records, it is now common for most multi-national companies to state while making tax returns that their companies are engaged in petty trading. For that reason they end up paying very little amount in tax for heavy profits made at the end of the year. In fact these multi-national companies have exploited the situation to the extent that some of them do not bother to make any tax returns.

The unfortunate result of this unpatriotic act is that the revenue that should have been accruing to the government for the development of the country has been going into the coffers of these companies and enriching aliens. This is even more grievous now that the revenue from oil is not as stable as before.

Now is the time for the Joint Tax Board to make more dynamic efforts to put an end to the ill. This could be achieved by directing the Ministry of Trade to forward the names and addresses of registered companies so that those that do not make their returns could be cross-checked on a

regular basis and appropriate action taken against them.

The Ministry of Finance as a matter of urgency should recruit more tax inspectors who would serve as field officers, checking organisations and individuals who usually pretend to be involved in petty trading while cleverly paying less tax from their profits. These officers would also be able to check companies that are in the habit of deducting taxes from their employees while they make no returns to the Inland Revenue.

As a follow-up, all companies found guilty of deducting taxes from their employees without making appropriate returns should be blacklisted. At the same time, our accounting institutions who handle financial dealings of business enterprises should advise their clients over the need to fulfil their obligations to the government by paying their taxes as and when due.

There is nothing worthwhile that must not be paid for. As we march towards economic self-sufficiency, all and sundry must cast their lot with the government by paying their taxes regularly.

## OCTOBER LECTURES

### 1981

DR. JOSEPH O. Mume will be the speaker on Radio Nigeria's "October Lectures" for this year. The series of six talks which is broadcast annually is usually a product of original research and it is designed to stimulate intellectual activity.

The topic of this year's lectures is: "Traditional Medicine". It is a field in which Dr. Mume is very well known.

Dr. Mume was educated partly at Eko Boys High School, Lagos and partly by correspondence course. He began the formal study of traditional medicine in Nigeria in 1955 and later proceeded to Britain, Sri Lanka and America to study 'Natural Therapeu-

tics', 'Herbalism and Biochemic - Therapy'.

Dr. Mume has attended several practical courses relating to traditional medicine in Britain and the United States of America. He obtained a PH.D Degree in Natural Therapeutics from the International University in Kam-pur, India.

In the six series, Dr. Mume will be talking about 'Herbalism; Traditional Surgery and Psychiatry' as well as on 'Native Therapeutics and Traditional Concepts of Health and Disease'.

Aged 52, Dr. Mume is married with children.

# NATIONAL GALLERY OF MODERN ART

— A New Nation-Building Instrument

IT is very gratifying to see the long-expected National Gallery of Modern Art formally opened during this 21st Independence Anniversary celebration. As far back as 1970, projection of visual and performing arts in Nigeria was conceived by the Federal Government.

National Theatre, which is performing art as National Gallery is to visual art, was completed in 1975. Gallery project seemed to be put in a cooler. This was due to economic reasons and convenience, eg. the importance of hosting the 2nd World Black and African Festival of Arts and Culture (Festac).

Though erection of Gallery was regarded secondary, the Federal Government formally gave prime consideration to its take-off. Immediately, bold steps were taken toward creation of fertile ground for visual art in Nigeria to flourish right from this 4th National Development Plan period. These steps comprise establishment of Ministry of Social Development, Youth, Sports and Culture; re-conditioning and redesigning of a part of the National Theatre into a temporary Gallery.

Other attempts include collecting expertise from bodies like the Society of Nigerian Artists (SNA) and individual artists, home and abroad; touring Nigeria's contemporary Art Zones, and

holding useful meetings. In effect the National Art Gallery started growing but with not much notice by the public.

On 25 September, 1980 the Presidential directive emphasised collection and proper use of Nigerians' artworks to project the image of the nation. To effect that call, the Federal Department of Culture took up opening a modest Gallery first, recruiting and training enough professional staff, and arranging to complete the main Gallery at Abuja.

The National Gallery of Modern Art is an indispensable educational and cultural instrument to disseminate Nigerian art both nationally and internationally. Artworks sorted on purely aesthetic grounds will preserve visual records of historical events and personalities in Nigeria; promote and protect creative citizens also.

It is open to international exhibitions for educational economic advantage to Nigeria and Nigerians. With constant publications of its artworks in all forms, eg. its maiden catalogue "THE NUCLEUS", the Gallery will drive Nigerian art into every home, and also generate fund for the Government.

As established, the Gallery will promote Nigerian contemporary art through acquisition from Nigerian and foreign artists. This will broaden

aesthetic consciousness of our public and promote art excellence in theory and practice.

The Federal Government can also provide Artists' Studios to run side by-side with the Gallery. National and international art workshops in different disciplines could be regularly organised too to benefit talented citizens. From these workshops Government might derive an easier way of acquiring contemporary artworks to swell the National Gallery of Modern Art.

At the moment the Gallery opened in the National Theatre at Iganmu, Lagos is modest, yet it carries its required impact toward building a viable nation through art.

# THANK U MAMA

## — It's Vicky Latest Release

FIRST thing first, Vicky Edimo is a fine vocalist, the possessor of a voice that sounds soaringly expressive of inner feelings. Ever before all he was a darling on the drums and bass guitar, having started at the age of 10 to play the drums in night clubs.

Vicky has shown a lot of promise in his latest release 'THANK U MAMA'. His music style may not represent any particularly defiable mainstream of 'black music', but he is original and genuinely moving, especially on such cuts tracks as 'Thank U Mama', 'It's Not Serious', and 'You'. You may, however, not have to find it compelling to bump all the time.

Generally, the lyrics seem essentially poetic; Thanks to his sister Louise who takes complete charge of all that. And still, more thanks to Jojo Kouoh (drums) and Eugene Edema, Emmanuel Baloka and George Achini on the guitar.

Vicky's album starts off with 'Thank U Mama'. Nice moving vocals by Vicky himself, with occasional haunting and irrepresible background vocals from Louise, Achini, and Asikpo. Soon, the listener begins to see why this won the title-track medal. The urge to tap the feet gets stronger and stronger as the track progresses. No doubt, quite juicy, and the head nods ceaselessly.

The second track 'Marina Drive' is slightly on the mellow side, but equally haunting, enough to make you shuffle the feet. The horns are significant here as they open all out in the first few seconds of play.

The drums and strings grind in earnest in the background. It is a total reminiscence of the Osibisa arrangement — the touch, the feeling, the spirit of it all keep reminding you that this is something similar to Osibisa. It is pure and simple, Vicky Edimo at his best and most original.

This identity is further clarified in the first track as you turn to the flip side. This is, 'It's Not Serious', with vocals not particularly as moving, although the orchestration in the background sounds grinding. The spirit of 'Thank U Mama' appears revived, especially as the conga-drums and percussions open out in earnest and the occasional mid-tone folksy whispering rumble in the background like a holocaust of angry birds.

The second track 'You', a hot

pounding Afro-rock, cracks off, giving the entire atmosphere the typical touch of a disco joint. But there is something funny in the track titles. In the tracks, 'Stormy Rain' originally listed on the sleeve as coming second on the flip side, suddenly swarms places with 'You' and therefore moves down to the last track.

The horns soon make themselves distinct, while the drums keep their cool in the background. As all these fuse together to present the solid Afro-rock it is, Vicky's voice filters in to warn: "You better know what you're doing or saying, everybody's watching you".

The last track 'Stormy Rain' is draggy and less appealing. The inspiring feature here however is the creative adaptation of the stormy atmosphere which reels violently in the background and occasionally forcing itself to the open.

'Thank U Mama' is not Vicky's first successful work. He had had two earlier Singles, 'Too Young' and 'Love Me To Night', produced by Daniel Vanguard (Known to be one of the best

producers in Europe) and which sell well in France, Belgium and England. 'Too Young' even got a place in the charts in England and Belgium.

Born in February, 1953, in Doue Vicky developed keen interest in music at the age of 10, starting with drums and then moving to bass guitar. In 1973, he travelled to Paris, with intention to study accounts, but switched over to music. In 1977, started doing some gigs with the Gi son Brothers, and in January 1979, got the opportunity to play with the late Bob Marley in a three-day concert which took place in Libreville, Gabon. He later made various appearances with different American musicians in America, Europe and Africa. Char Bobbit, the then James Brown's Manager, picked him up and decided to sponsor him for a one-year course at the Berklee School of Music in Boston, Massachusetts. Vicky's greatest ambition is to make his music in Africa and export it to the world outside.

# Significance Of Id-el-Kabir

**ID-EL-KABIR** which literally means the Greater Festival is also known as Id-el-Adha, the Festival of sacrifice. The origin goes back to the time of prophet Ibrahim and his first son, Ismail.

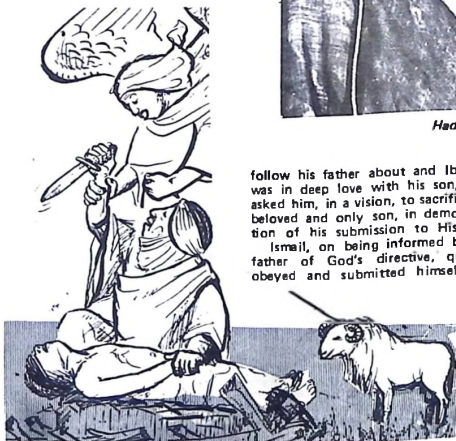
Prophet Ibrahim had looked for a child for many years but could not get any. In addition he suffered in the hands of his unbelieving idol-worshipping people when he called on them to believe in Almighty God.

After submitting Himself entirely to the will of God, he prayed, saying: "My Lord, grant me a righteous son," (Q. 37. 101.). So, God gave him a son, whom he named Ismail.

When Ismail was old enough to

follow his father about and Ibrahim was in deep love with his son, God asked him, in a vision, to sacrifice his beloved and only son, in demonstration of his submission to His will.

Ismail, on being informed by his father of God's directive, quickly obeyed and submitted himself for

sacrifice in obedience to the command of Almighty God. But God did not allow Ibrahim to slaughter his son. He only tested his faith. God therefore told Ibrahim to slaughter an animal for sacrifice in place of his son.

This month, Id-el-Kabir is celebrated in commemoration of prophet Ibrahim's readiness to sacrifice his first son, Ismail in obedience to the command of Allah.

From the above, Muslims have great lessons to learn on the value of submission to the will of and devotion to God, as prophet Ibrahim did.

Ismail also teaches us to object to the practice of human sacrifice and replace it with that of sacrificing animals.

Another lesson is that if one wants to win God's love, one has to sacrifice that which you love most.

# Nigerian Constitution

to all matters with respect to which the National Assembly has for the time being power to make laws.

Subject to the provisions of the Constitution the executive powers of a State are vested by the Governor of that State and may, subject to the provisions of any Law made by a House of Assembly, be exercised by him either directly or through the Deputy Governor and Commissioners of the Government of that State or officers in the public service of the State.

The Executive powers shall also extend to the execution and maintenance of the Constitution, all laws made by the House of Assembly of the State and to all matters with respect to which the House of Assembly has for the time being power to make laws. Such executive powers shall, however, be so exercised as not to impede or prejudice the exercise of the executive powers of the Federation or to endanger the continuance of a Federal Government in Nigeria.

The President shall not declare a state of war between the Federation and another country except with the sanction of a resolution of both Houses of the National Assembly sitting in a joint session; and, except with the prior approval of the Senate, no member of the armed forces of the Federation shall be deployed on com-

bat duty outside Nigeria.

## THE JUDICIARY

In any democracy the Judiciary plays an important role. It is possible, due to human failings, for the Legislature or the Executive to err on point of law. In consequence, the rights of the individual could be trampled upon. For instance, a citizen's property may be acquired by the Government without adequate compensation being paid to him.

Or, on the other hand, a well-placed citizen in the society may use his position to assault a less privileged citizen. Without the existence of the court of law which deals with either civil case to look into the non-payment of compensation to the aggrieved plaintiff or criminal procedure to look into appropriate punishment for the offender or accused, any hope for redress would be lost.

According to the constitutional document, the judicial powers of the Federation are vested in the courts established for the Federation. The judicial powers of a State are vested in the courts established for a State.

The Courts established by the Constitution for the Federation are the only superior courts of record in

Nigeria; and serve as otherwise prescribed by the National Assembly or by the House of Assembly of a State, each court has all the powers of a superior court of record.

The judicial powers extend, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Constitution, to all inherent powers and sanctions of a court of law, and to all matters, between persons, or between government or authority and any person in Nigeria, and to all actions and proceedings relating thereto, for the determination of any question as the civil rights and obligations of that person.

These powers shall not, except as otherwise provided by the Constitution, extend to any issue of question as to whether any act or omission by any authority of person or as to whether any law or any judicial decision is in conformity with the Fundamental Objectives and Directive Principles of State Policy set out in the Constitution.

Moreover, the judicial powers do not extend to any action or proceedings relating to any existing law made on or after 15th January, 1966 for determining any issue or question as to the competence of any authority or person that makes any such law.
