

## ABUSE OF RED BIRO IN OFFICIAL PAPERS

It has been observed that Chief Executive Officers, Director-Generals, Executive Secretaries of Government Agencies, Vice-Chancellors of Federal Universities, Rectors of Federal Polytechnics, Provosts of Federal Colleges of Education, Chief Medical Directors of Federal Teaching Hospitals, Medical Directors of Federal Medical Centres, and Heads of Allied Government Institutions, sign off their letters and minutes in files using red biro or ink.

- 2. This action is in contravention of established practice in the Public Service as provided in the extant handbook.
- 3. Specifically, Chapter 13, Section 34 of the Revised Civil Service Handbook (2010 Edition) provides inter alia, that, "...all officers should use blue, black biros or ink on all official papers... Ministers use red, and the Audit staff use brown pencil..., the green colour is exclusively reserved for the highest authorities..." (i.e. President, Vice President, Governors, Deputy Governors).
- 4. Accordingly, all functionaries mentioned in paragraph 1 above, are to desist from using red biros or ink which is exclusively reserved for Honourable Ministers.
- 5. Honourable Ministers are to draw the attention of all concerned and who are under their purview, to the contents of this circular for **strict** compliance.
