DISSOLUTION OF BOARDS OF FEDERAL GOVERNMENT  
PARASTATALS,

AGENCIES INSTITUTIONS AND GOVERNMENT-OWNED COMPANIES

I write to inform you that the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, Bola Ahmed Tinubu, GCFR in the exercise of his Constitutional Powers and in the Public Interest has approved the dissolution of the Governing Boards of all Federal Government Parastatals, Agencies, Institutions and Government-owned Companies.

2. The dissolution does not, however, affect Boards, Commissions and Councils listed in the Third Schedule, Part I, Section 153(1) of the 1999 Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (as amended).

3. In view of the foregoing development and until such a time new Boards are constituted, the Chief Executive Officers of the Parastatals, Agencies, Institutions and Government-owned Companies are hereby directed to refer matters requiring the attention of their Boards to the President, through the Permanent Secretaries of their respective

supervising Ministries or Offices. Permanent Secretaries are however, directed to route such correspondences to Mr. President

through the Office of the Secretary to the Government of the Federation.

4. All Ministries, Departments and Agencies are to ensure compliance with the provision of this Circular which takes effect from Friday, 1 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2023. Permanent Secretaries are particularly advised to inform the Chief Executive Officers of the affected Agencies under the supervision of their respective Ministries/Offices for immediate compliance.
