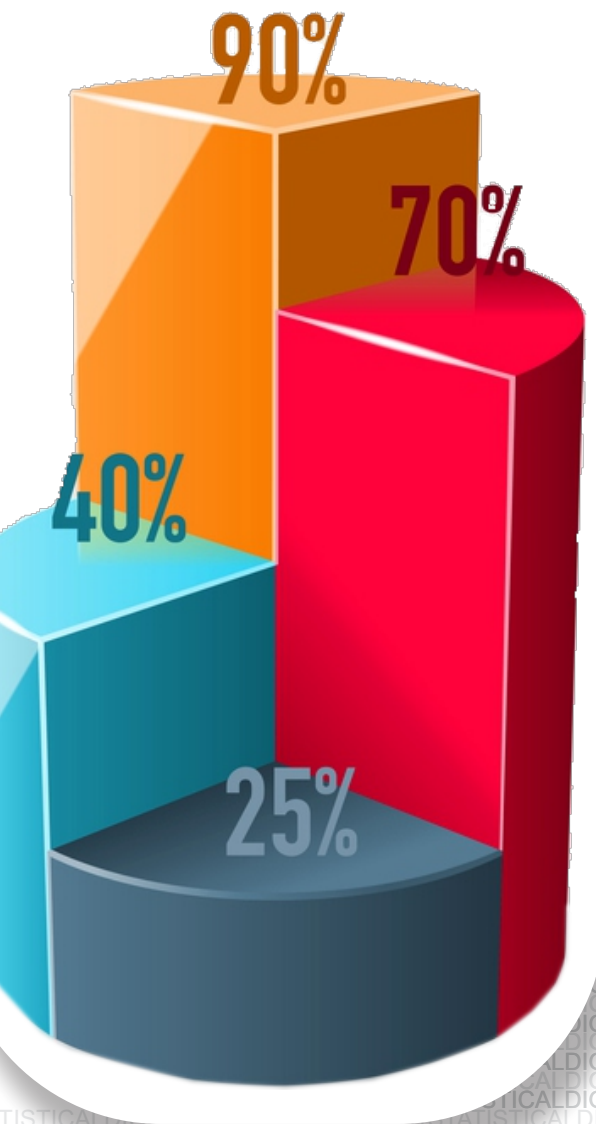

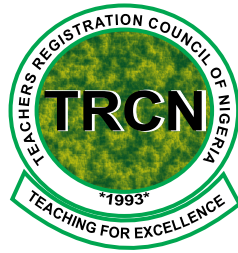
The Statistical Digest contains analysed data based on the following;

# INTRODUCTION



## TEACHERS REGISTRATION COUNCIL OF NIGERIA

### *Vision*

An effective regulated teaching profession in Nigeria founded upon robust teacher education and practice, where teacher quality, discipline, professionalism, reward and dignity match international standards

To assure excellence and professionalism among teachers at all levels of the Nation's education system; using effective registration, licensing, accreditation, monitoring and supervision of teacher education programmes, promoting continuing professional development and maintenance of discipline as paradigms for the overall renaissance of the teaching profession in Nigeria.

Teaching for Excellence

## TRCN Mandates

The Teachers Registration Council of Nigeria (TRCN) was established by Act 31, of 1993 (now CAP T3 of 2004) in fulfilment of the quest for the professionalization of teaching. Nigerian teachers had over the years clamored for the establishment of a regulatory Council of their own as obtained for all professional groups to regulate the practice of their profession.

TRCN CAP T3 of 2004, Section 1(I) charged the Council with the following responsibilities:

- Determine who are teachers;
- Determine what standards of knowledge and skills are to be attained by persons seeking to become registered as teachers and raising the standards from time to time as the circumstances may permit;
- Securing in accordance with the provisions of the Act the establishment and maintenance of a register of teachers and the publication from time to time of the lists of those persons;
- Classifying from time to time members of the teaching profession according to their level of training and qualification;
- Performing through the Council established under this Act, the functions conferred on it by the Act.

### Implications of TRCN Mandates

The Act, in section 17(2) provides that on coming into effect of the law, it becomes an offence for an individual to teach, pretend to teach, use the tag of a teacher or earn the reward of a teacher without being registered by TRCN.

The Act, in section 7 and 8 empowers TRCN to accredit, supervise and monitor courses and programs of all teacher training institutions, which includes; Faculties and Institutes of Education of Nigerian Universities, Colleges of Education, Schools of Education in Polytechnics and the NTI. The law also empowers the Council to withdraw recognition from any of these institutions that fail to meet the standards set, and graduates of such institutions cannot be registered nor licensed and hence not qualified to practice.

Section 9 of the Act provides for the establishment of Teachers Investigation Panel [TIP] in all the States of the Federation including the FCT and Teachers Disciplinary Committee [TDC] which is a Tribunal at the TRCN Headquarters. The TIP investigates and verifies allegations of breach of professional ethics by teachers and forward cases to TDC for trial and punishment.

Sections 6, 13 and 1(i)(b) empower the Council to prescribe internship program, conduct qualifying examination to ascertain suitability of candidates before registration and set standards of knowledge and skill to be acquired and raise those standards from time to time through programs designed to continuously improve the quality of teachers in addition to mandatory professional development courses.

### **Internal**

- We are committed to excellence in everything we do and we strive to continually improve our services. We are passionate about achieving results that exceed expectations of our own and others. We deliver for results with energy and a sense of urgency;
- Respect for the view points and interest of government and all stakeholders;
- Belief in comprehensive consultations with stakeholders as a means to an adequate understanding of the problems of teacher education and how to solve them.

## **Our Programs & Activities**

The activities and programmes of the Council as obtains in other professional agencies includes:

- Registration and licensing of teachers;
- Quality assurance in teacher education in form of accreditation and monitoring of teacher education programmes, introduction of Professional Diploma in Education (PDE), Professional Standard of Nigerian Teachers (PSNT), Manual of Mandatory Continuous Professional Development (MCPD), Code of Conduct for Nigerian Teachers, Induction Brochure, and Benchmark for PostGraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE), etc.;
- Internship and induction schemes for fresh Education graduates to ensure that they possess the critical skills required to discharge their professional responsibilities;
- Continuous professional development programmes to keep teachers abreast of developments in the field;
- Regulation of the ethics of the profession especially through the machanisms of the Teachers Investigating Panels (TIP) and Teachers Tribunal;
- Leadership of ideas, research and development in the teaching profession through scholarly publications, etc.;
- Annual Conference of Registered Teachers in Nigeria;
- Innovations in public policies to upscale the dignity, rewards and recognition of the teaching profession in Nigeria;
- Providing attestation for Nigerian teachers wishing to teach abroad in order to fast-track their recognition and registration by the foreign Teaching Councils;
- Serving as a voice for the teaching profession in Nigeria at the global level;
- Constructive engagement in all other respects necessary to improve the education, practice, conditions and image of the teachers in Nigeria;
- Conduct of Professional Qualifying Examination for teachers desiring to be registered and graduating students as a form of assessing their competence;
- TRCN is co-hosting the African Forum of Teaching Regulatory Authorities (AFTRA) Headquarters with South Africa. The Registrar/Chief Executive Prof. Josiah Olusegun Ajiboye is the Deputy-President of AFTRA.
- TRCN is a member of the International Forum of Teaching Regulatory Authorities (IFTRA).

BY STATE AND GENDER [PRIMARY] 2015

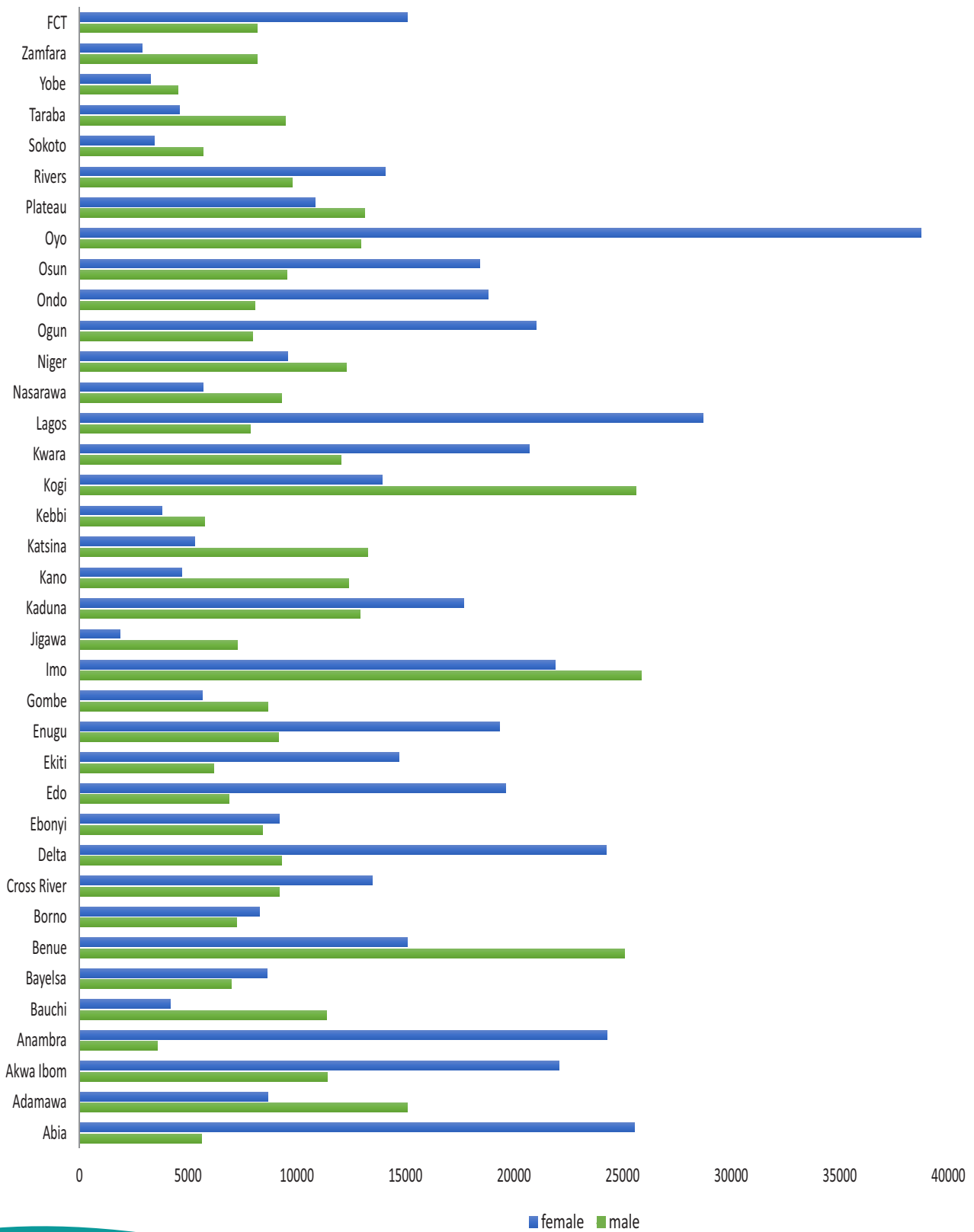

Figure 2: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [PRIMARY] 2016

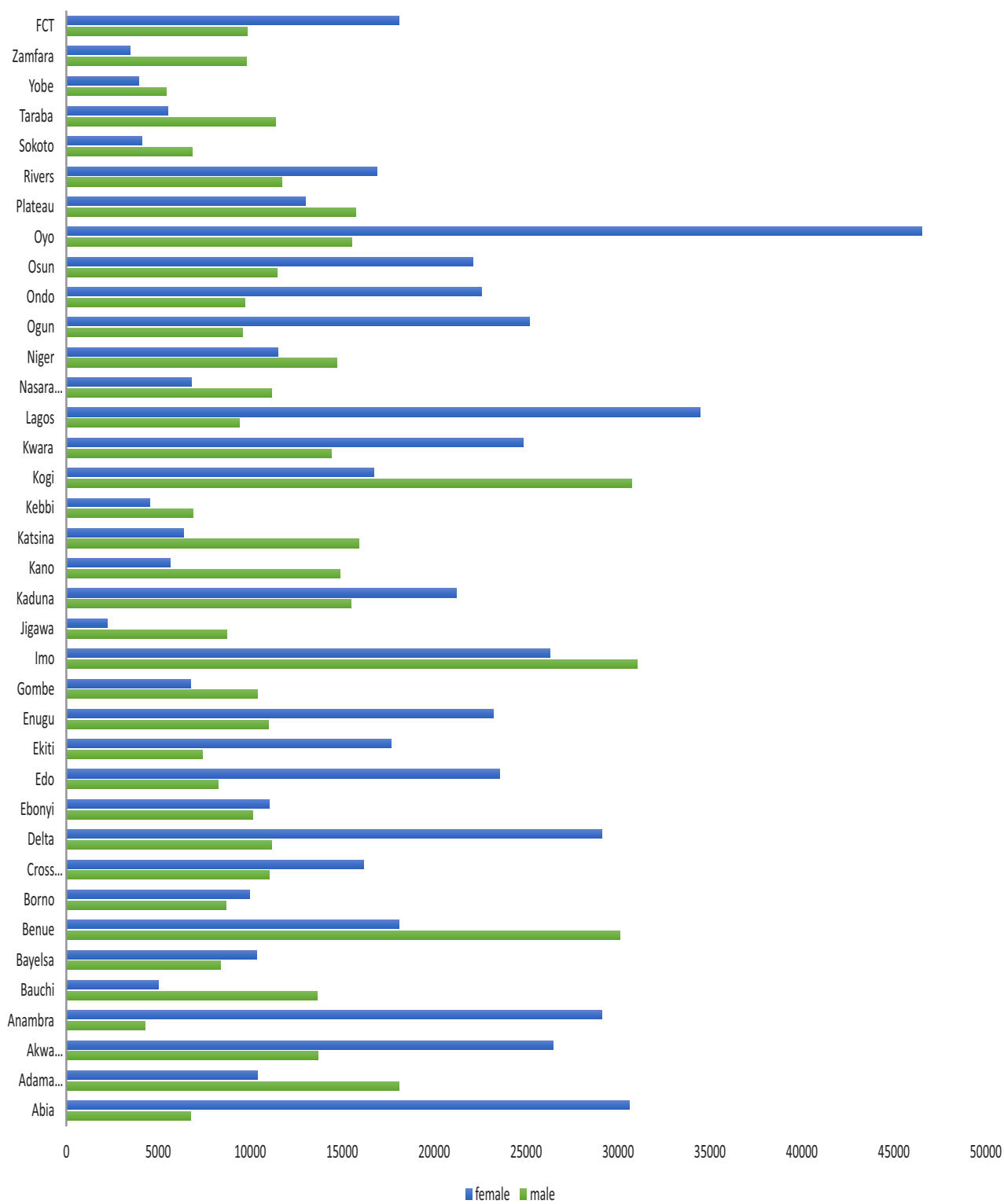

Figure 3: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [PRIMARY] 2017

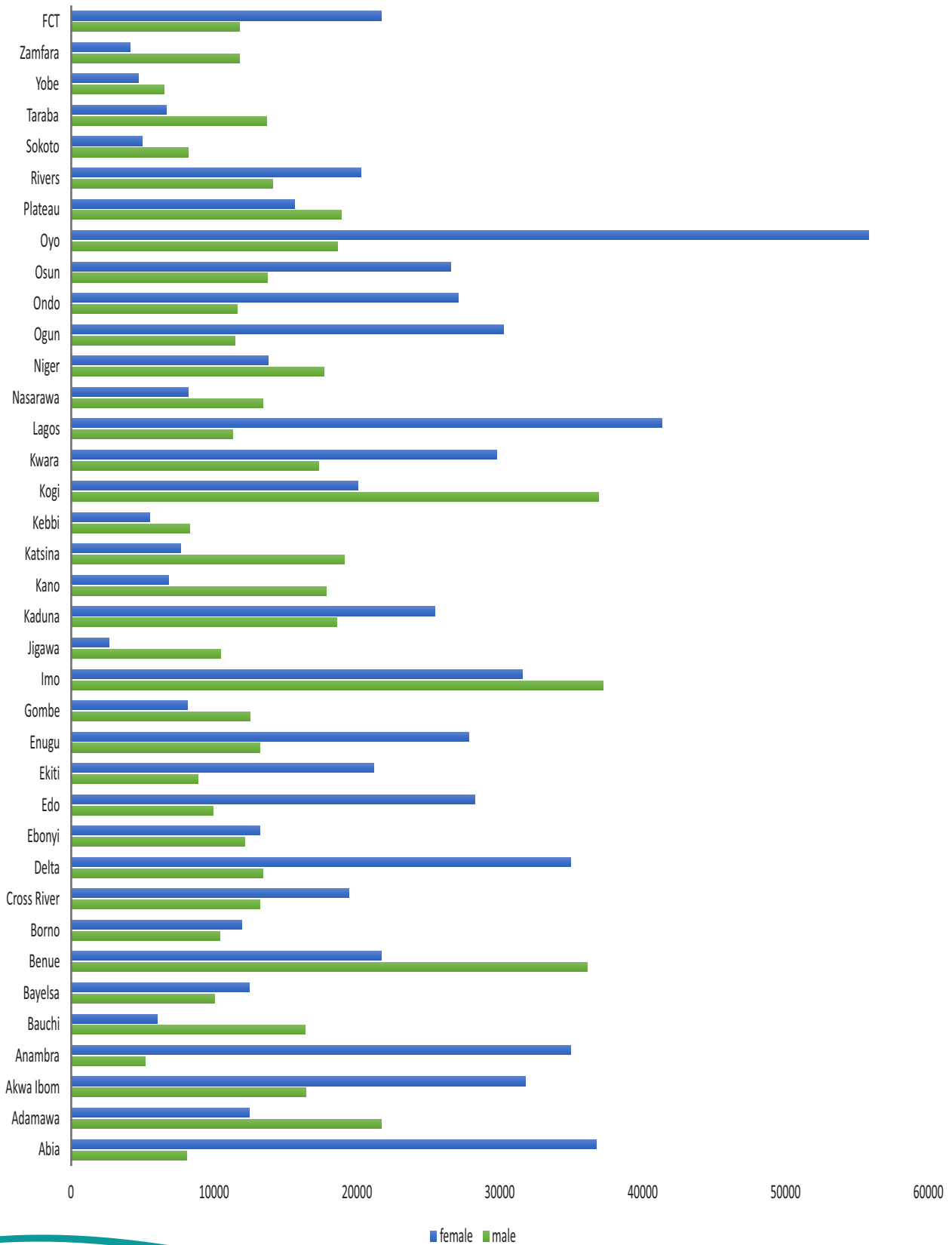
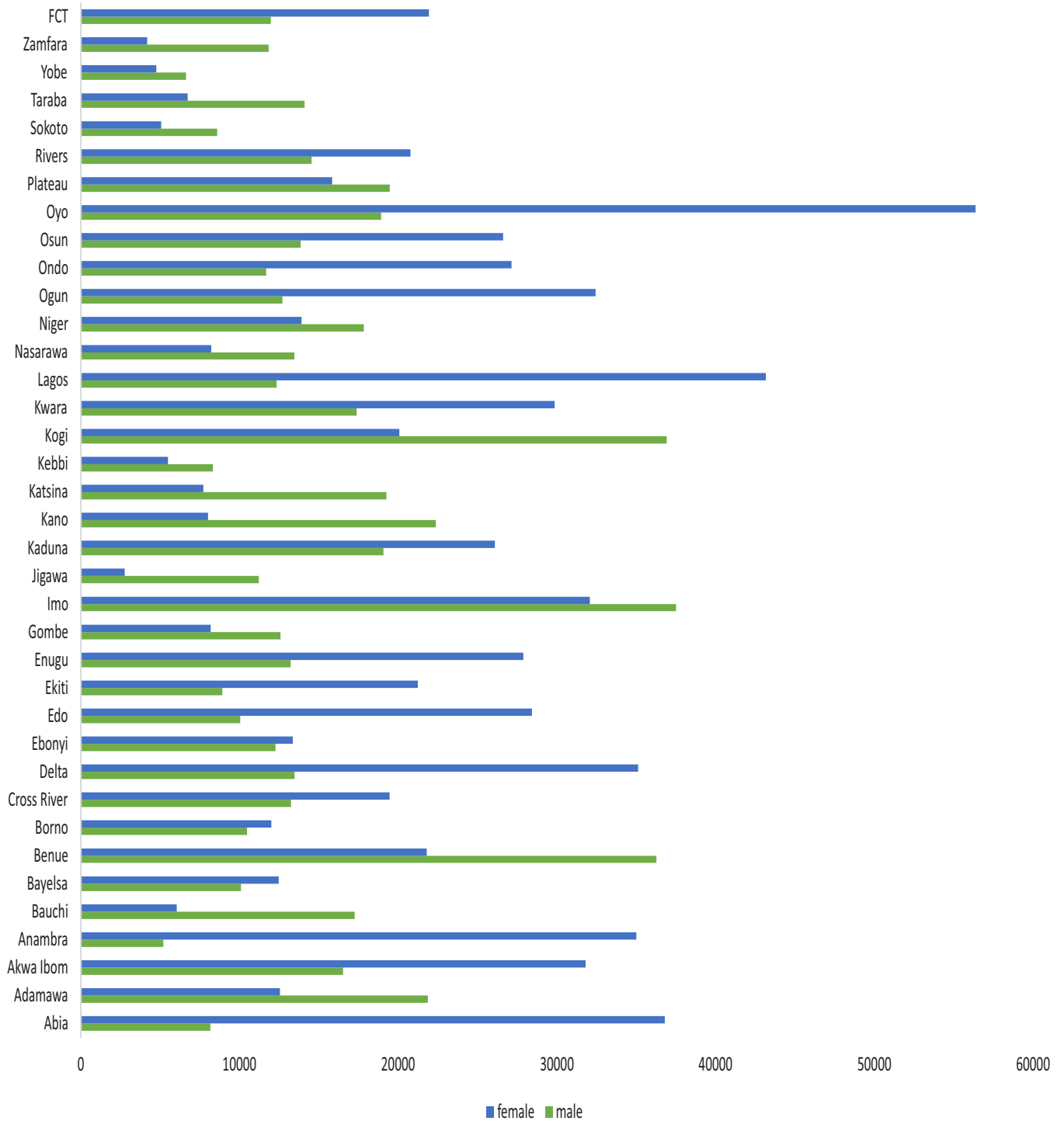

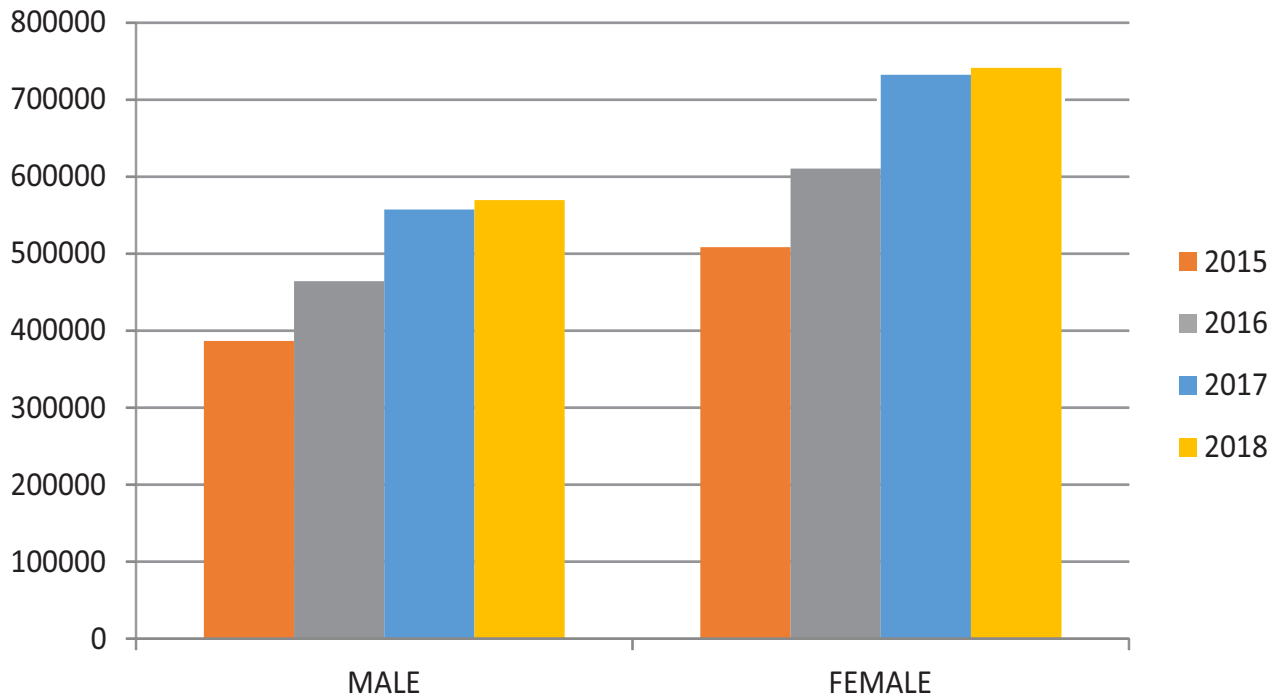
**Figure 4: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [PRIMARY] 2018**

**Figure 5: SUMMARY OF TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS [PRIMARY] 2015-2018**



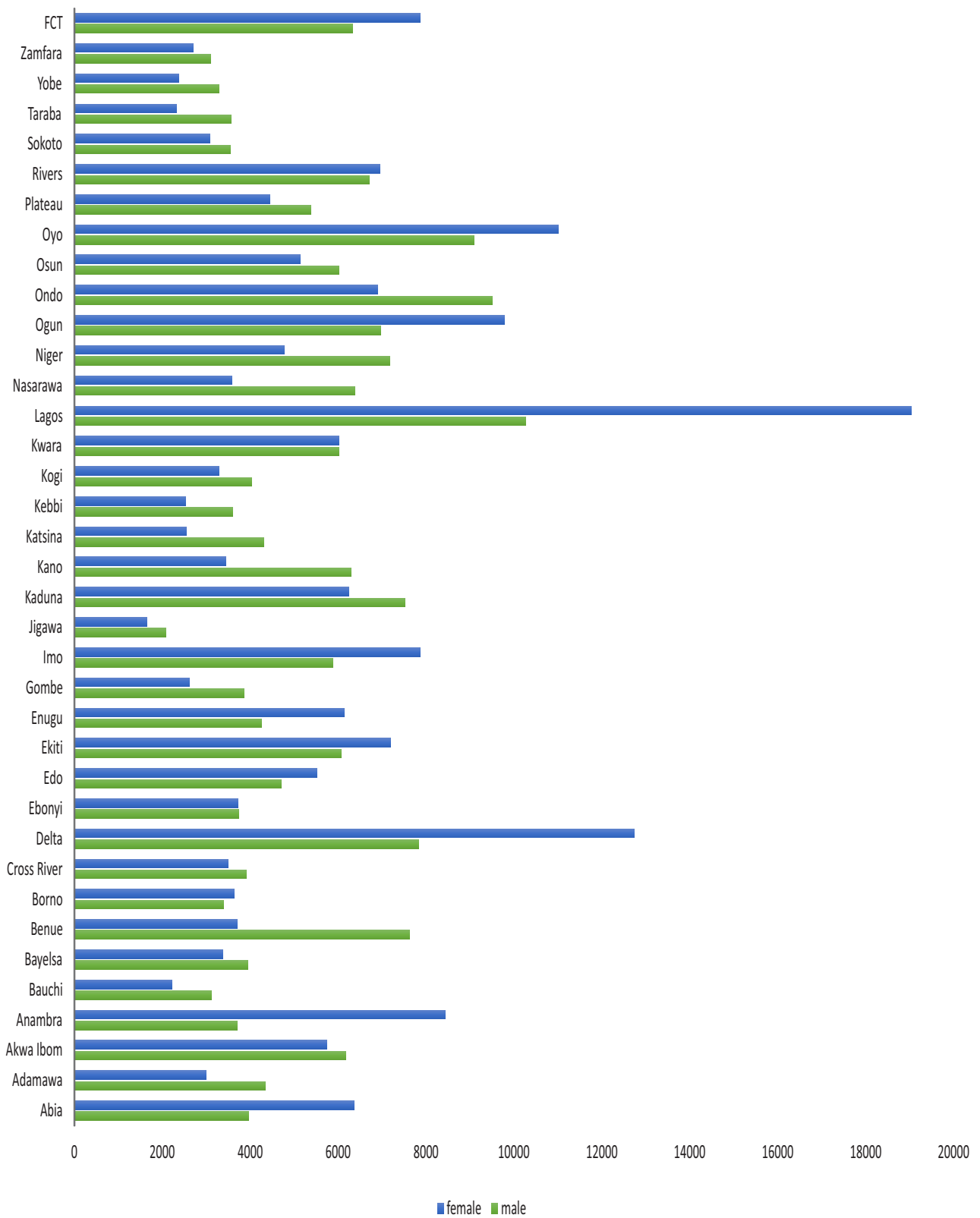

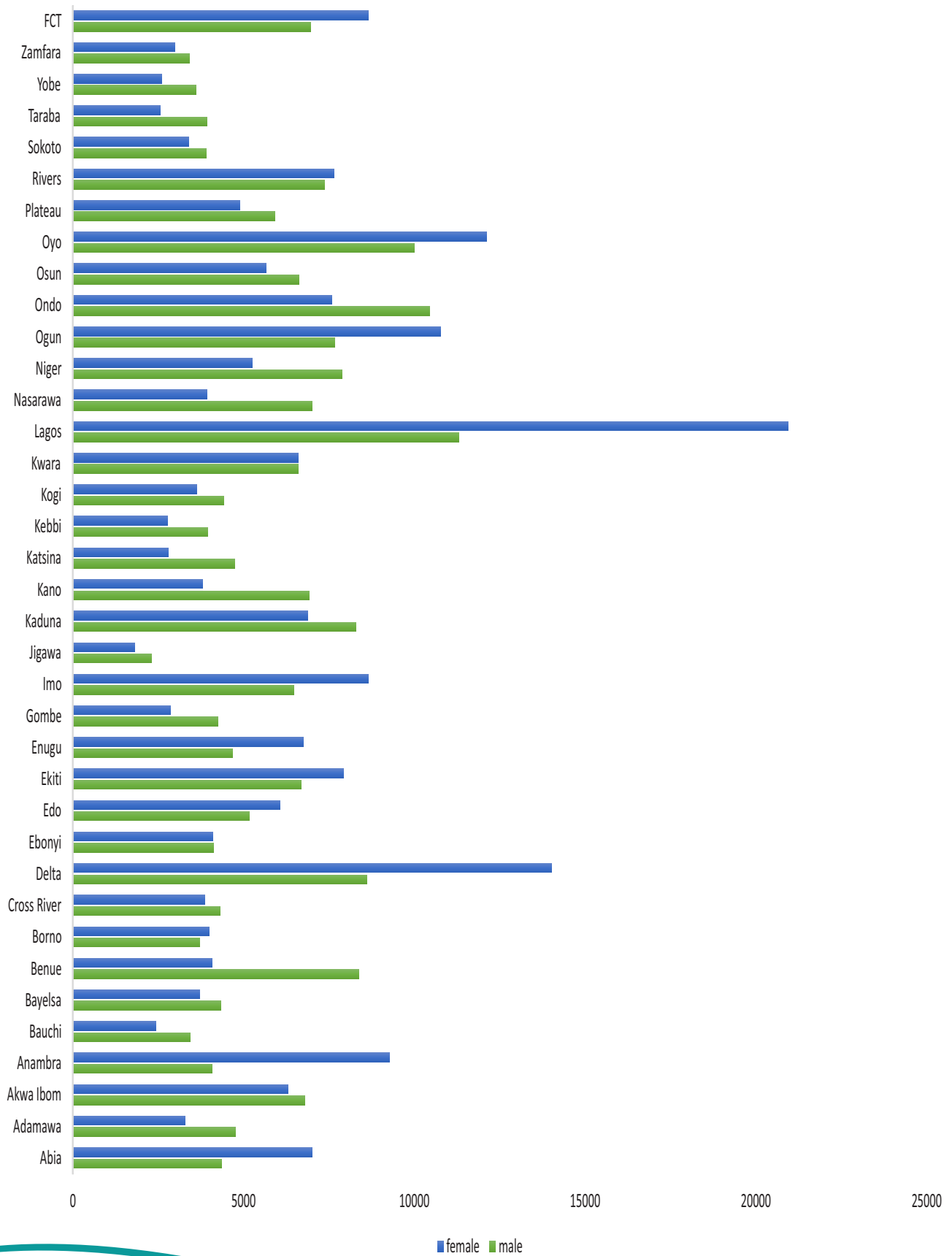
**Figure 6: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [SECONDARY] 2015**

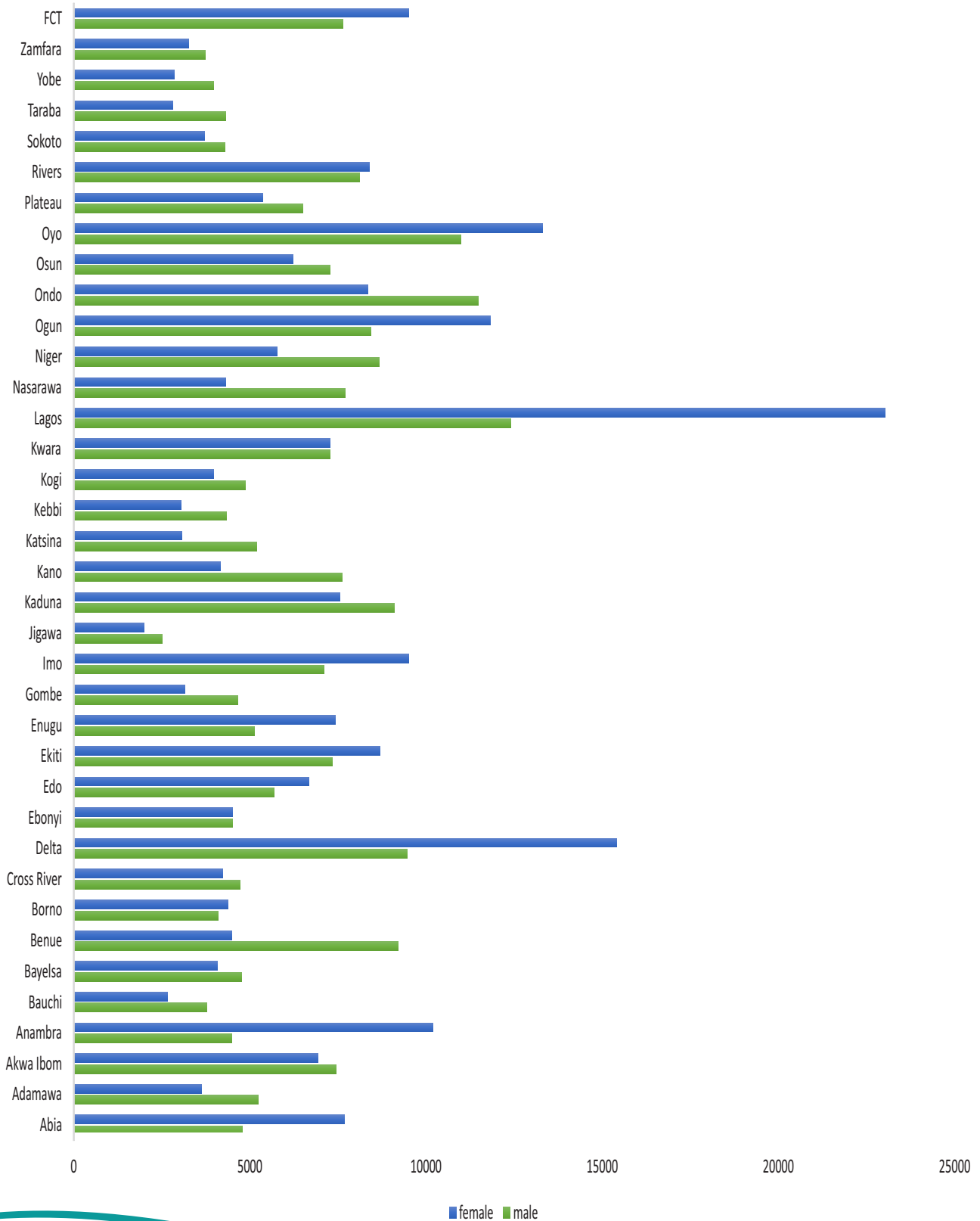
**Figure 7: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [SECONDARY] 2016**

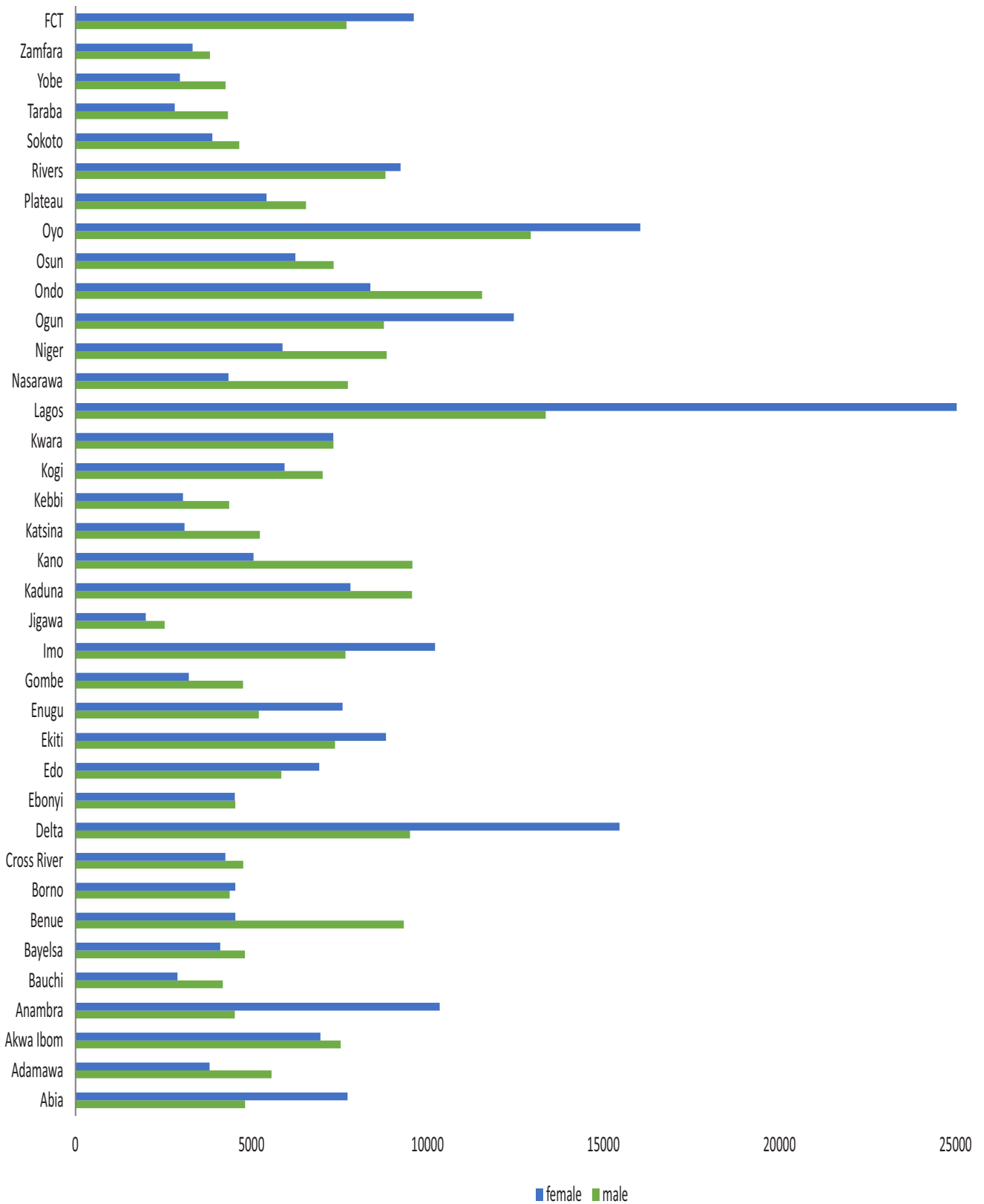
**Figure 8: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [SECONDARY] 2017**

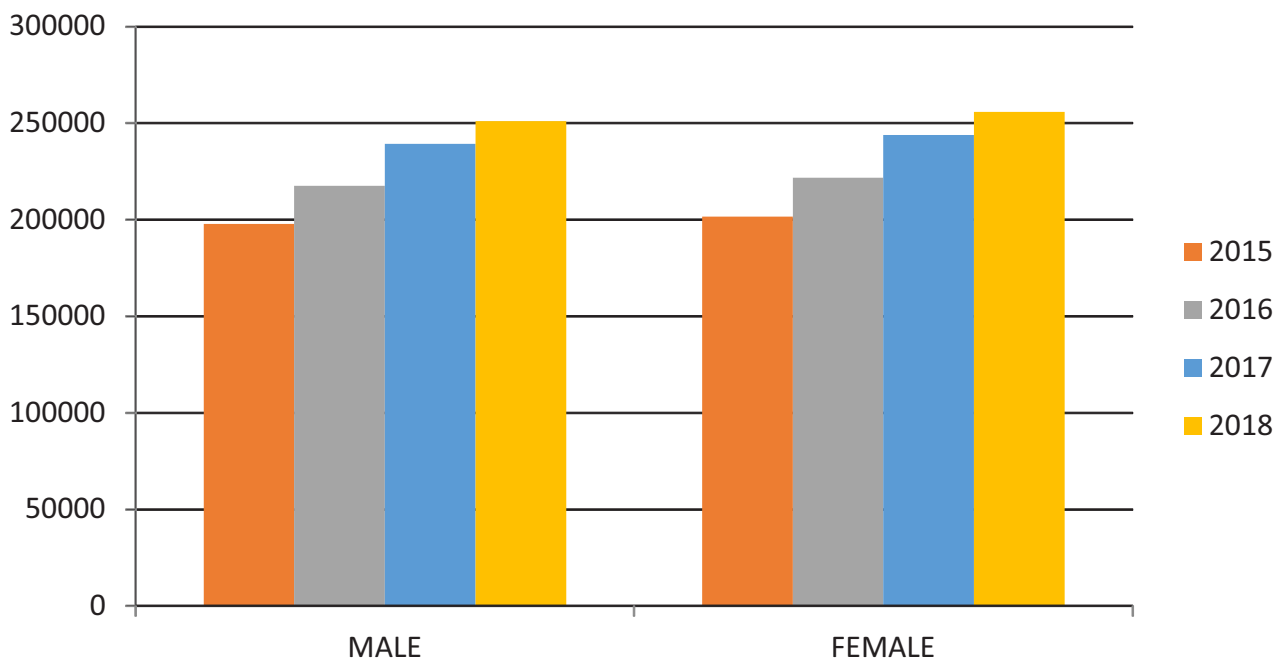
**Figure 9: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [SECONDARY] 2018**

**Figure 10:** SUMMARY OF TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS [*SECONDARY*] 2015-2018



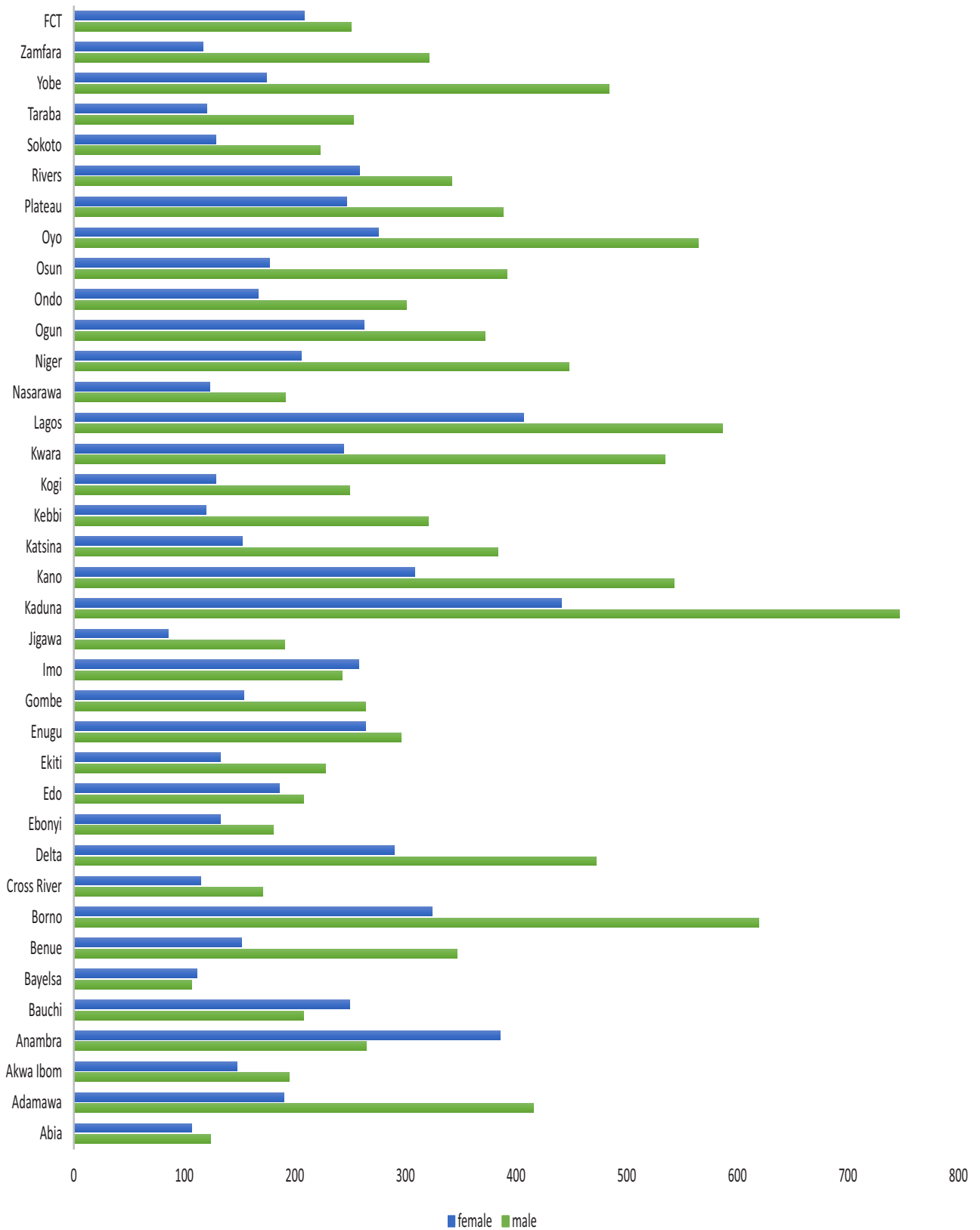

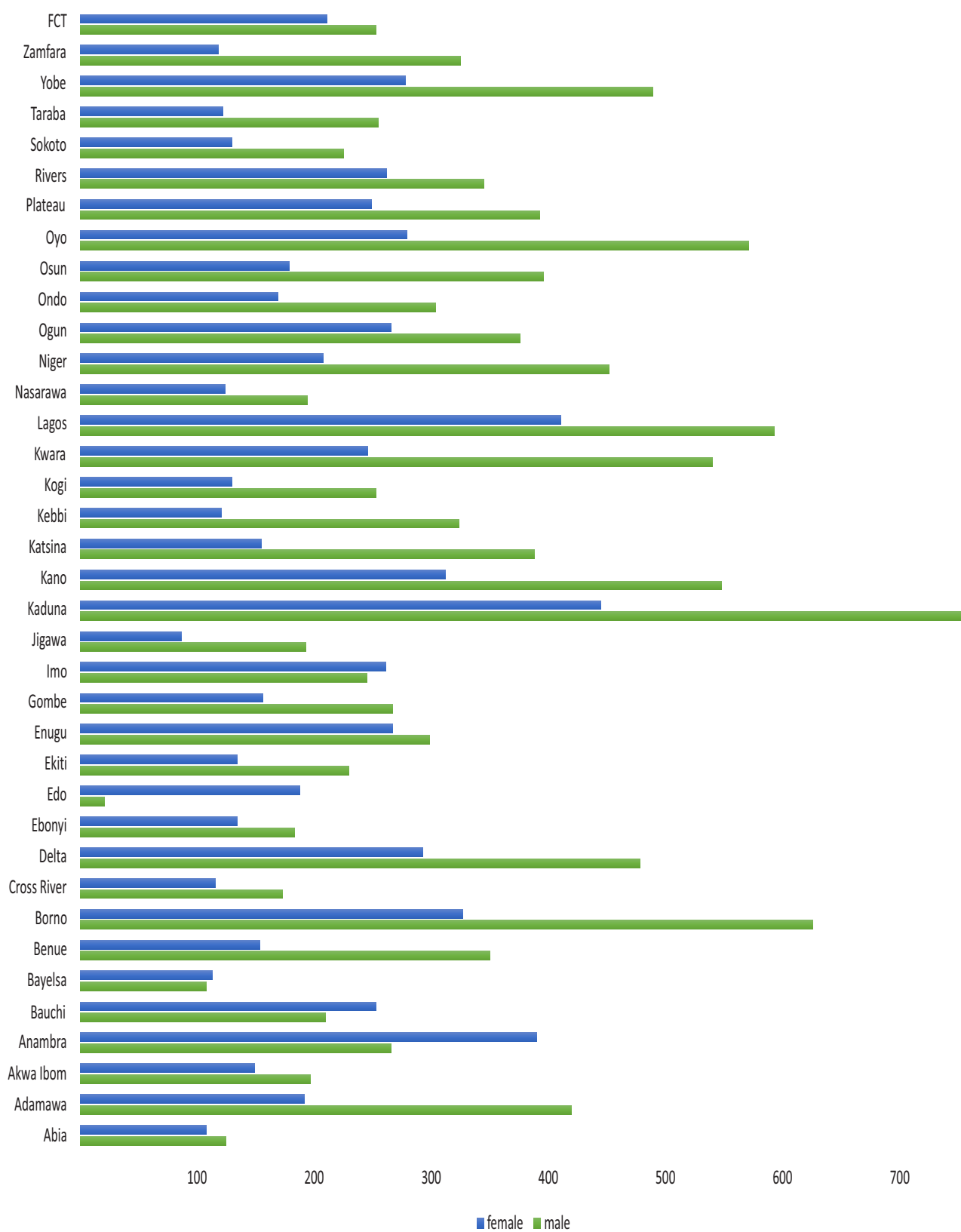
**Figure 11: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [TERTIARY] 2015**

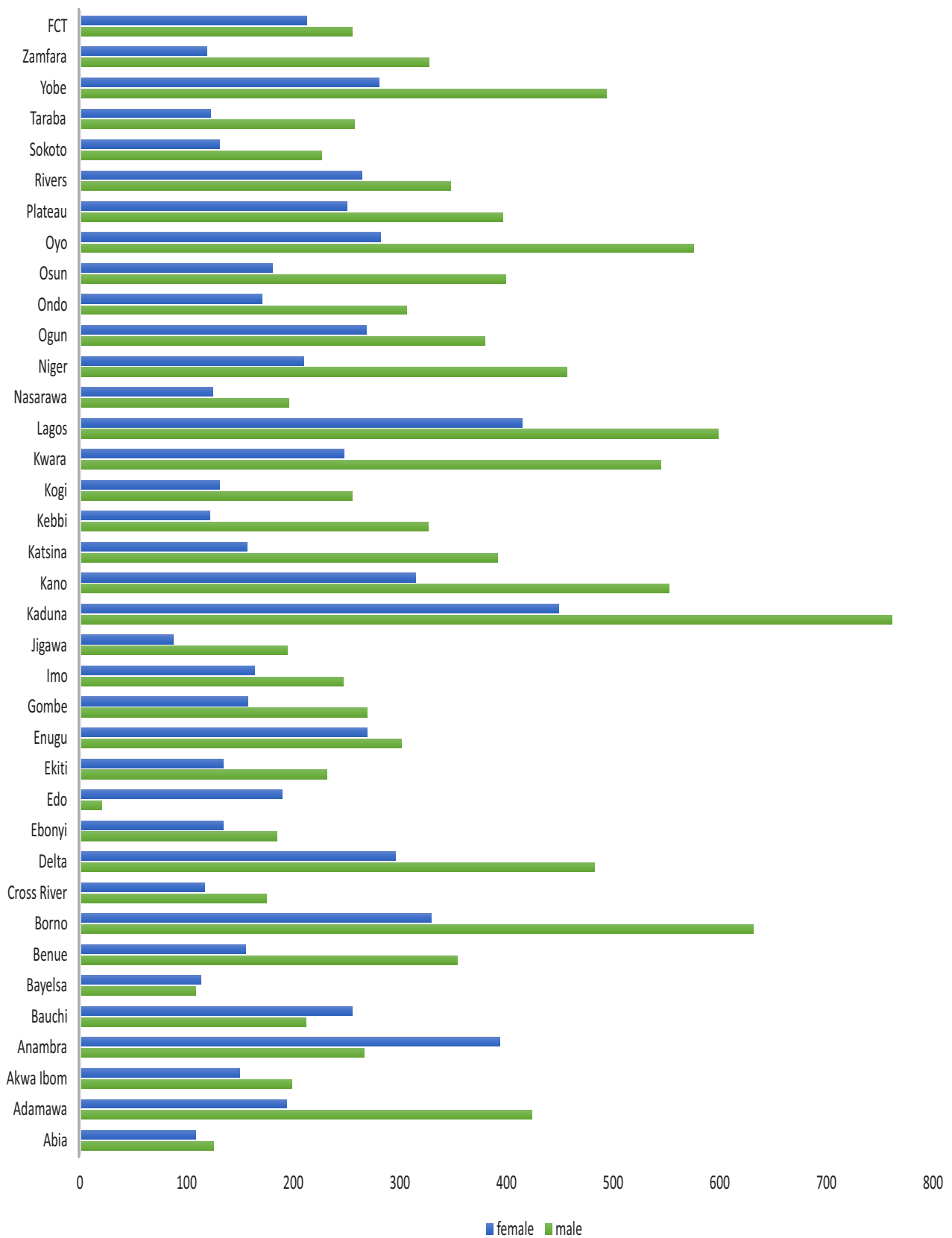
**Figure 12: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [TERTIARY] 2016**

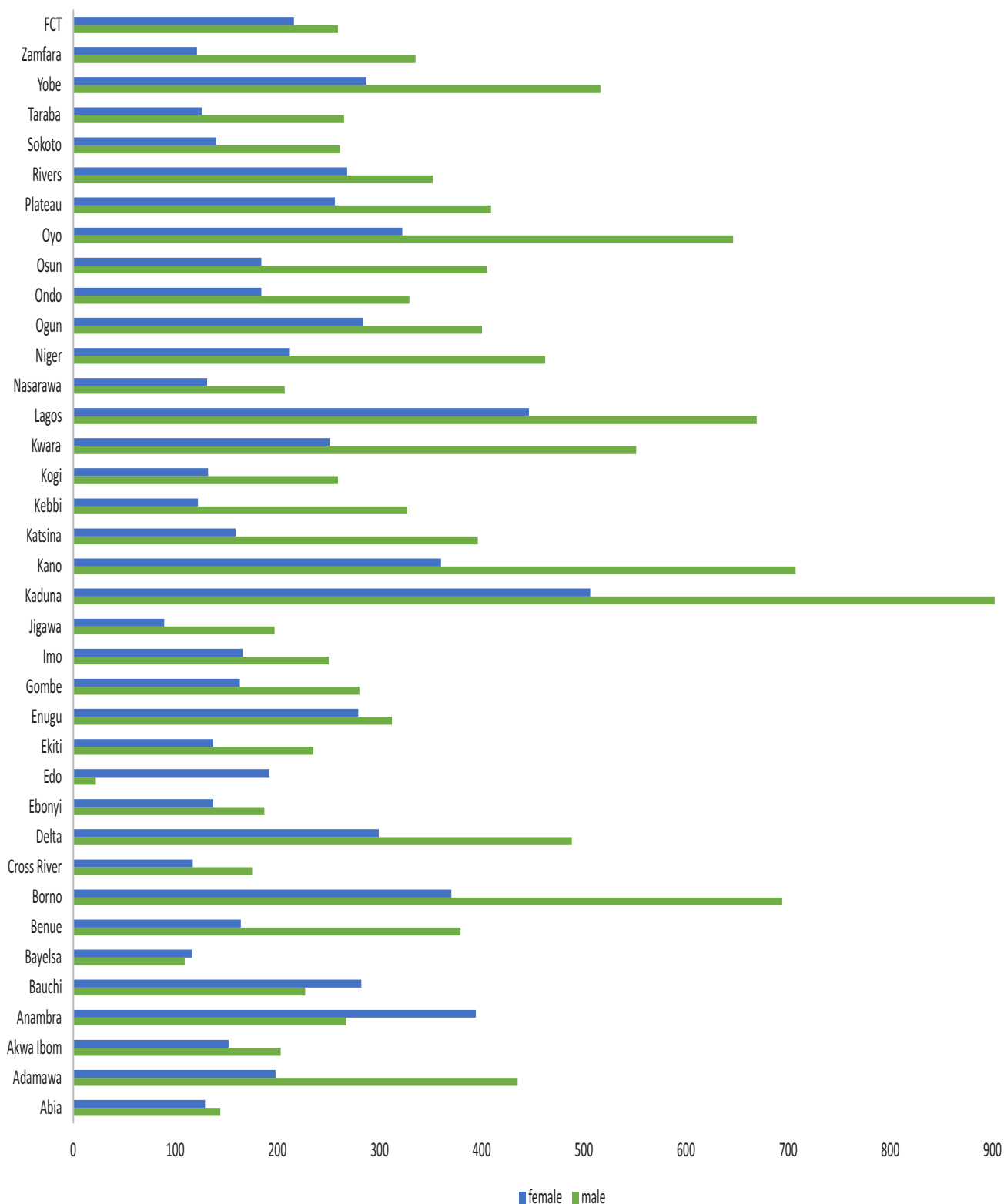
**Figure 13: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [TERTIARY] 2017**

**Figure 14: TRCN REGISTERED MEMBERS BY STATE AND GENDER [TERTIARY] 2018**

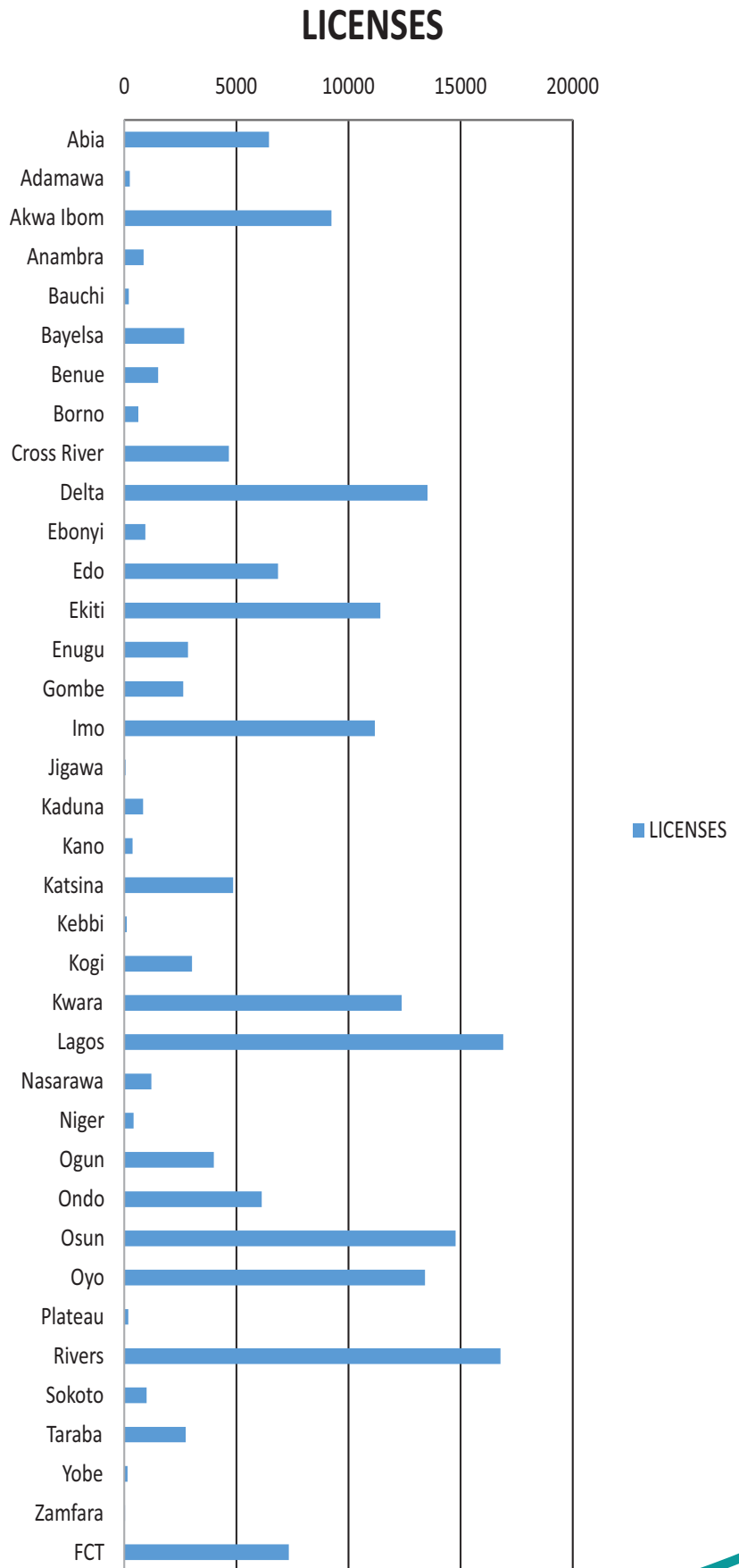

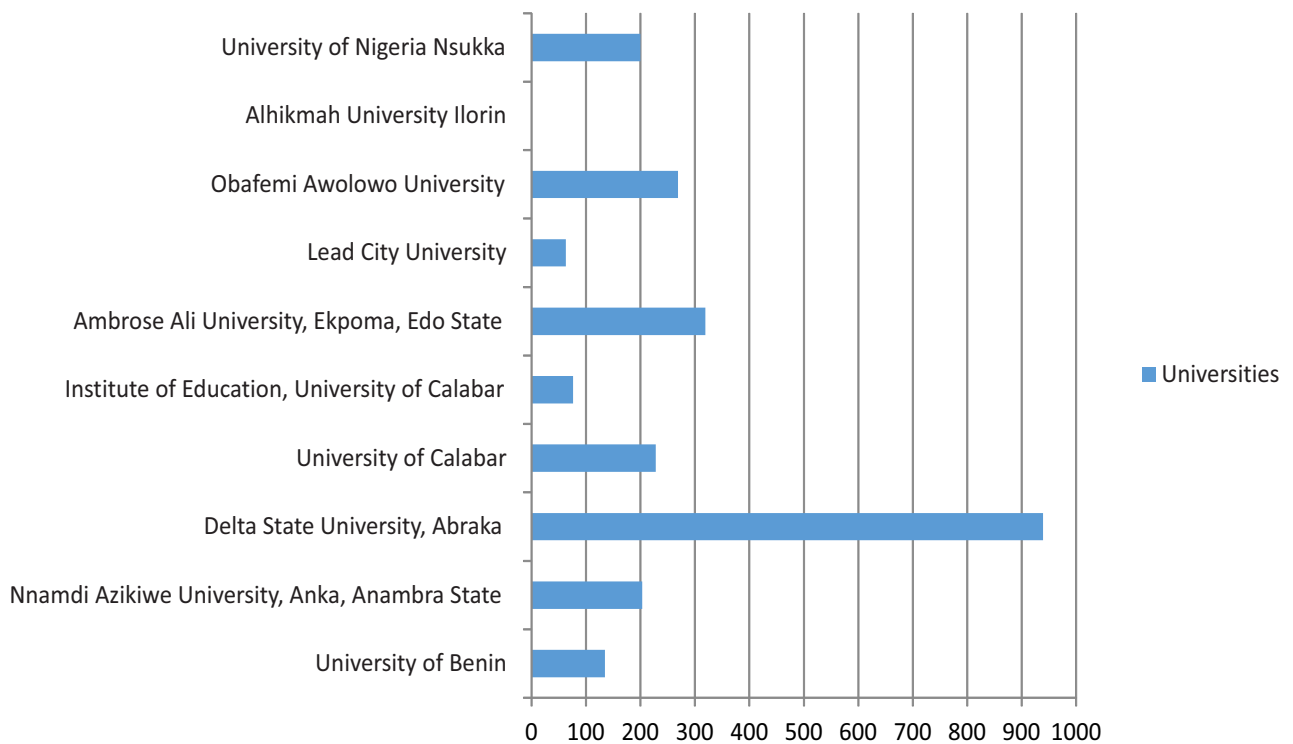

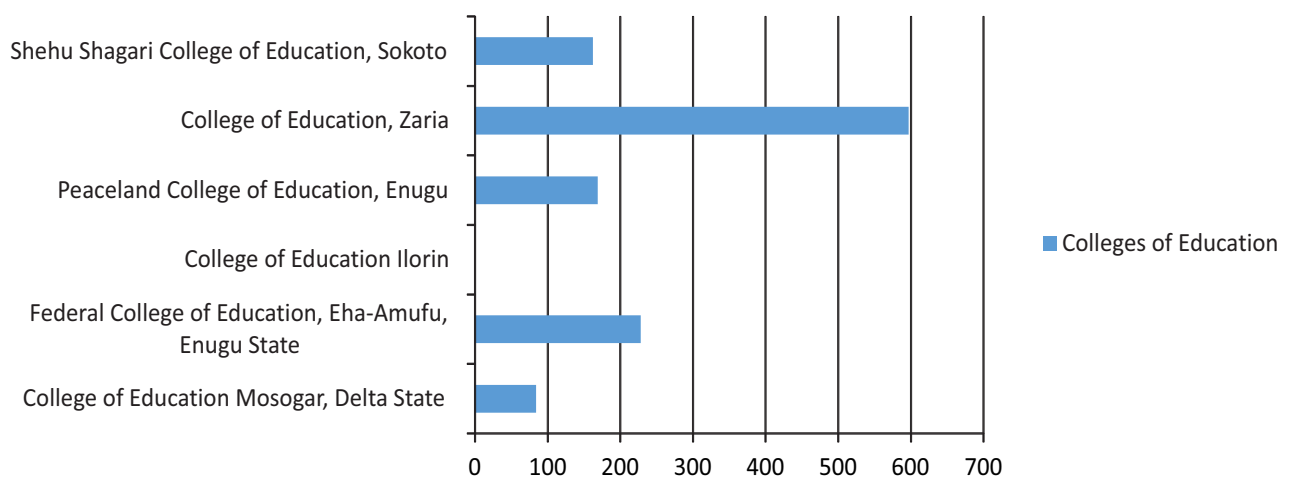

Figure 17: PROFESSIONAL QUALIFYING EXAMINATION DATA 2017

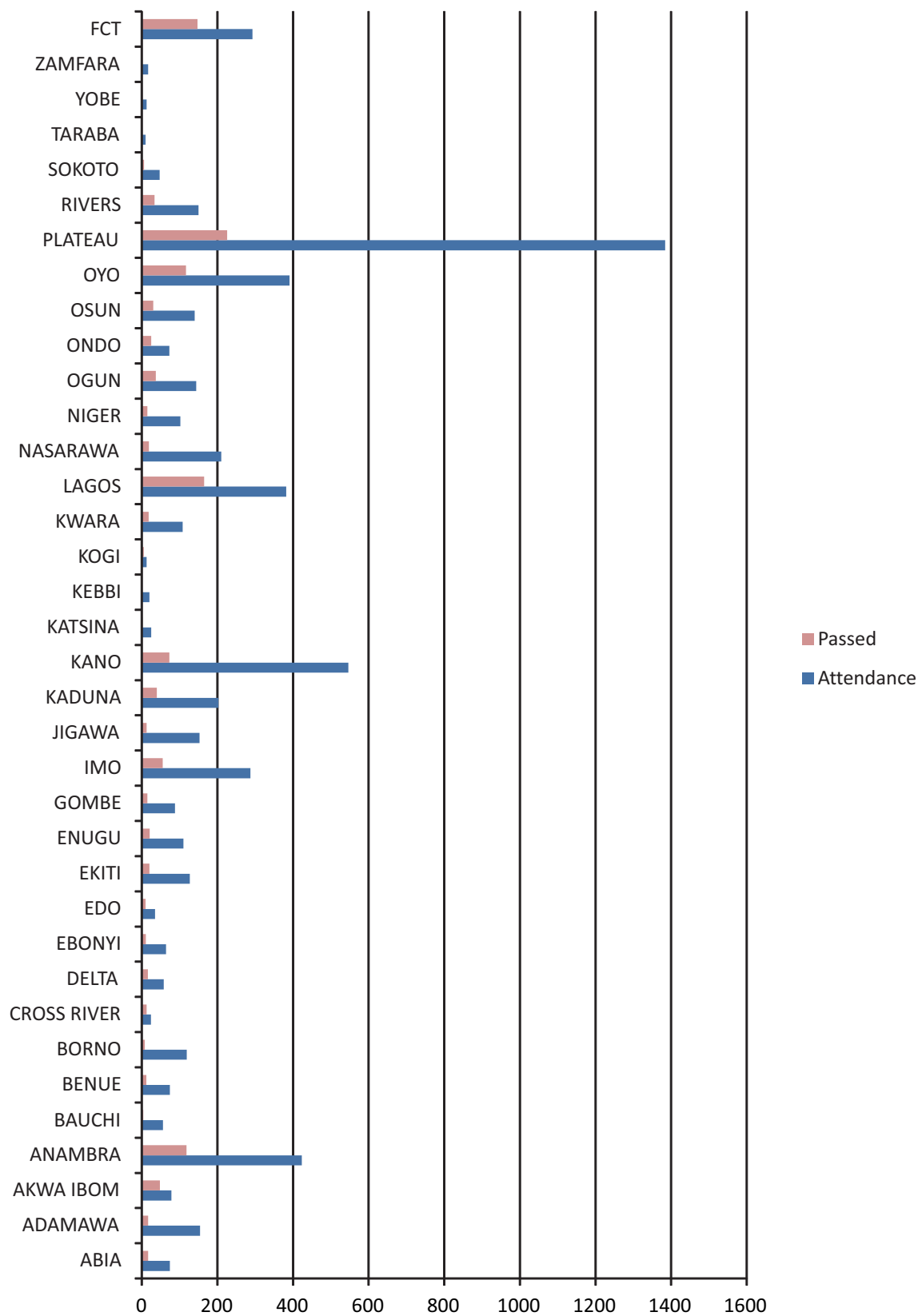

Figure 18: PROFESSIONAL QUALIFYING EXAMINATION DATA 2018

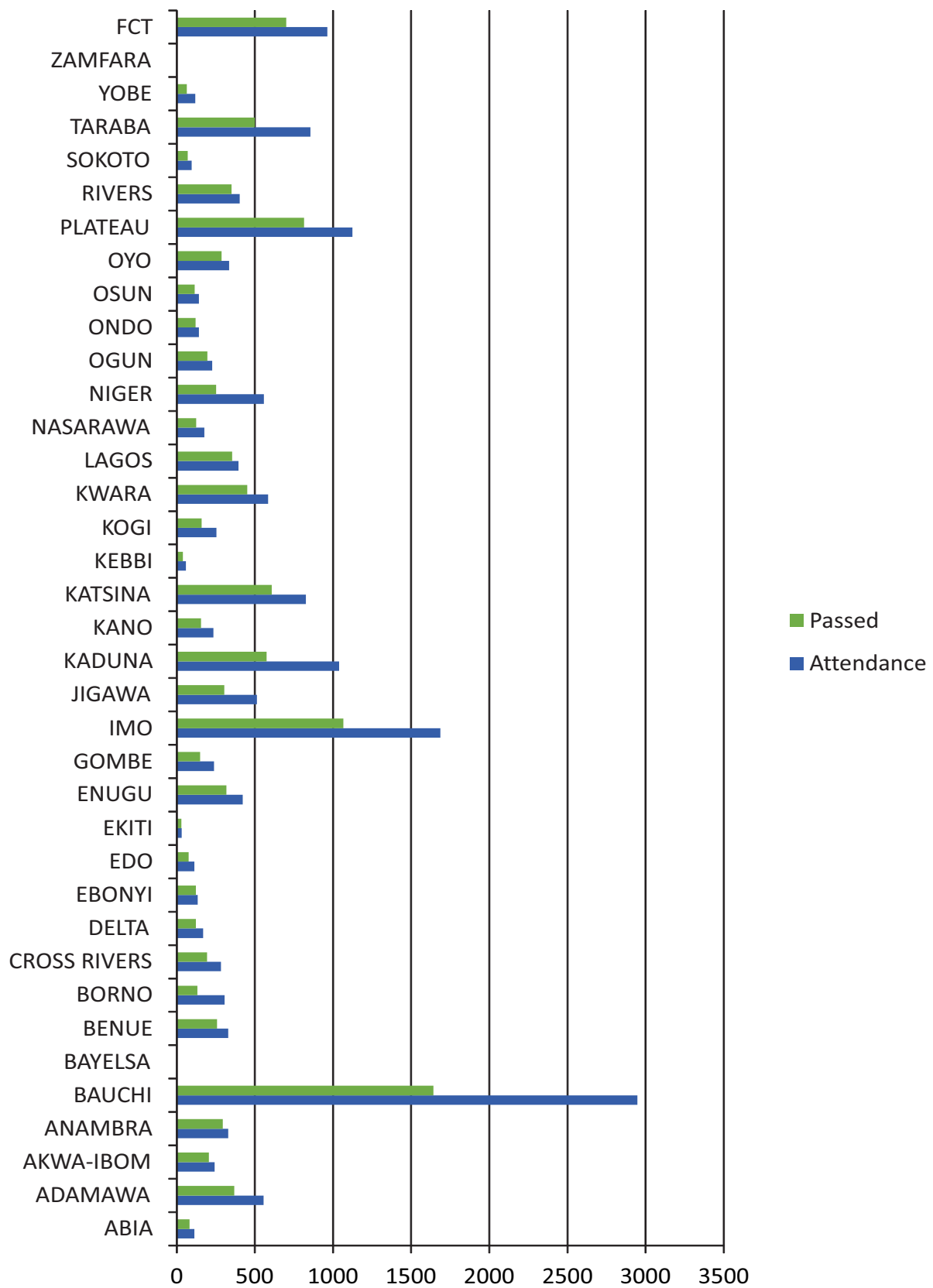

Submitted papers are circulated for review without the author's names and institutional identifications. Papers must be prepared in accordance with NJPT WRITING GUIDE included here below.
2. Articles should be headed by an abstract of not more than 200 words.
3. Quoted passages of more than three typed lines should be extracted and indented 5 spaces and typed single-space. Shorter quotations should be enclosed in single inverted commas.
4. Footnotes are not permitted. The journal follows the author/date system of citation by which references is made in the text by citing the author's surname and date of publication of the work. Only published references should be cited.
5. All works cited in the text must be listed under reference in alphabetical order of author's surnames.
6. The Editorial Board reserves the right to accept or reject where it is unavoidable to meet its standards/requirement and such decision is final.
7. All papers submitted will be circulated for review/assessment and feedback given to the authors within stipulated time.
8. Authors whose papers are considered publishable are to pay a token fee of N10,000 only to have their papers published. An author of published article will receive one copy of the Journal free.
9.
